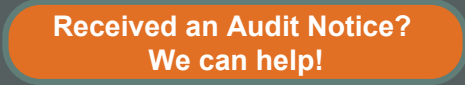
The law requires you to accurately report on your tax return all income you receive. If payers don't send you proper information forms (for example, Form w-2 for wages or Form 1099 for interest or dividends), you must estimate your income based on your paycheck stubs, deposit slips, or other records and report this estimate on your tax return.

The law requires us to charge interest on unpaid tax from the due date of the return to the date you pay the tax in full. The law doesn't allow us to reduce or eliminate interest based on reasonable cause. We've enclosed Notice 746, Information About Your Notice, Penalty and Interest, which gives more detail on our interest charges.

If you don't agree with our proposed changes, write to us and tell us why. If you agree with our proposed changes, sign the "Consent to Tax Increase" at the end of this letter. If you filed a joint return, you and your spouse must sign the consent.

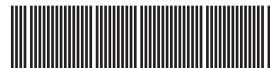
