### What you need to do

- **To pay by debit or credit card:** Visit [www.irs.gov/e-pay](http://www.irs.gov/e-pay) for information on paying taxes by a debit or credit card.
- **To pay by Same-Day Wire:** Visit [www.irs.gov/e-pay](http://www.irs.gov/e-pay) for information on this payment option. Check with your financial institution for deadline and fees.
- **To pay by check or money order:**
  - Mail your payment to Internal Revenue Service, PO Box 1211, Charlotte NC 28201-1211.
  - Make your check or money order payable to the United States Treasury.
  - Include your tax ID, tax form number, and the tax period on your payment.

You are responsible for submitting your payment to IRS by the due date. This isn't a bill. If you owe, IRS will send you a bill. However, you don't need to wait and can submit payment as soon as possible for the amount you believe you owe to avoid or limit penalty and interest charges.
